I have now had a chance to show the images to our Archivist.

We both agree that this piece was produced by a student who attended the Vienna School of Art Needlework. It is not possible to put an exact date on it, but it would have been produced in the late 19<sup>th</sup> or early 20<sup>th</sup> Century. The Vienna School is no longer in existence, so it may prove a little difficult to find further information today. It was formed in 1878, six years after the RSAN began, and was structured somewhat similarly with a high standard of work produced by the students. I have put out some feelers in the world of Arts and Crafts and trust to gain some further information for you.
