I have now had a chance to show the images to our Archivist.

We both agree that this piece was produced by a student who attended the Vienna School of Art Needlework. It is not possible to put an exact date on it, but it would have been produced in the late 19th or early 20th Century. The Vienna School is no longer in existence, so it may prove a little difficult to find further information today. It was formed in 1878, six years after the RSAN began, and was structured somewhat similarly with a high standard of work produced by the students. I have put out some feelers in the world of Arts and Crafts and trust to gain some further information for you.
